Discernment Practices – Review Get Rid of the Clutter and Chatter (Turmoil)

In order to hear God's voice, we must turn off the clatter and turmoil that is forever trying to vie for first place in our minds. Well, you may ask I don't see how this can ever stop. There are so many ideas and thoughts and chatter continually going on in my brain...

Ask God to help you become quiet before Him and to enable you take this peace with you wherever you go. God will meet you. A good way to start stepping into the stream of discernment is to try to settle yourself inside, but be assured the fleshly thoughts will start coming.

At this point you need to begin to pray by speaking scripture verses or singing or praying for others or in tongues. Do this for just a little while at first. Keep your mind on the present. Do not think about other things. Live in the moment. Do not be bound by worries and time. Let it go. God has more for you...

Cover Other's Nakedness

To walk with the Holy Spirit at heartbeat's closeness we need to practice agape love. This is a type of love that watches out for his brother. It is a love that does not talk about others behind their backs. It is a love, which does not gossip. It is a love, which does not expose other's faults. It is a love that wishes the best for each individual.

We cannot all be ears. We cannot all be eyes. We cannot all be hands. We cannot all be feet in the body of Christ. But we are all commanded to treat others with the utmost care and concern.

If we talk about others in a manner which is less than full love, the Holy Spirit will not be able to come through to you in the way which is most powerful – where you can hear that still small voice as your helper and comforter in all that you do.

Worship

Worship is our highest calling. I believe our ability to do great exploits and have strength in this world is based on our worship of God. God desires pure worship. We should come to a point in our lives where we want to worship often and with passion.

Worship expands our being so that even our every breath becomes as praise to the Lord. We need to be cognizant of the fact that our every action is apprised of the Spirit. When we eat we are worshipping God. When we play we are worshipping God. When we socialize we are worshipping God. When we work we are worshipping God. Each and everything we do should is a manifestation and extension of our love and devotion to Him.

It does not have to be top 40 perfect in order to release God's powerful protective shield for you. As you walk in worship your soul will manifest of being in the presence of God with the accompanying fruits of the spirit.

Pray

Prayer is our connection to God. Prayer connects us to God's divine enablement. We must pray at all times. Everything we do should be as a prayer to God, when we pet a cat, when we walk our dog, when we paint our house, when we study our schoolwork, and when we go to our job. All beings need to be aware of the presence of God manifesting around and about in the moment.

A personal prayer life must be developed in order to form a relationship with the Heavenly Father. Jesus tells us to pray in secret. What we do in secret will be rewarded openly. We are not to go around boasting of all the time we spend with God. God sees it and He will REWARD us openly.

After some time is spent pursuing the presence of God in your life, God will begin to reveal His still, small voice to you. It is NOTHING you can think up. It is entirely separate. God will let you know. Listen. The Maker for this designed you. It is not a fantasy.

Tithe

Many people resist tithing because it is commanded in the Old Testament. The whole Bible is ours today. The promises are for now. Yes, we are under grace, but if you truly want to experience the fullness of God in every way in your life you must tithe.

God promises to open us the windows of heaven and pour us out a blessing that there will not be room enough to receive it.

I truly get excited to tithe. I know God is watching. It is incredible to see the hand of providence move in unbelievable ways – not just finances but in relationship with Him, divine protection, and divine enablement.

People who resist tithing are hurting and limiting themselves. God wants to bless us. This is the avenue God tests our allegiance in this world. Is our allegiance to Him or is it to money and the fear of not having enough?

Purpose

It is my hope that the Holy Spirit will bless everyone who looks at or even touches this book beyond measure. The Holy Spirit is deeply concerned with each of our lives. He cares about everything we say, think, or do. He cares about decisions we are about to make, and will make.

God has given us everything we need for life here on earth. We are not separate from Him. He is right here with us. He is right here with us now. He wants to make His will known to us in a very personal way. We all are receptors for God's love if we will simply allow and accept it to flow within our lives.

All believers can be blessed from a real touch of God abiding in their lives.

Epilogue

To walk in Discernment we need to remember the words of the Old Testament "This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth but you shall meditate therein day and night that you may observe to do all that is written therein for then you will make your way prosperous and then you will have good success. Joshua 1:8.

To walk in discernment scripture says to "Study to show yourself approved unto God a workman that needeth not be ashamed rightly

dividing the word of truth. II Timothy 2:15. God stands beside us as a mighty warrior. God wants us to be knowledgeable about His Word. We are to be gentle as doves yet wise as serpents. When we study His word, we allow Him to metamorphosis every molecule and fiber of our being. We become strong. He replaces our brass for gold and our iron for silver and our wood for brass and our stones for iron. Isaiah 60:17. We are not meant to be something the devil wipes around. We are meant to be bold and courageous, full of might and power.

or anything it is too late to dig for the power verses, you need to be prepared. You need to have the power verses on the tip of your tongue and be ready to speak them out over your situation. Yes, you can still call on the Name of Jesus, but it will be another trek around the mountain. I don't know about you but I want to go forward. I want to occupy the land the Lord promised my ancestors and your ancestors and their descendants.

God wants you to keep His fire kindled. Scripture says, "I remind you to rekindle the gift of God that is within you for God has not given us a spirit of fear but of power and of love and of a sound mind. II Timothy 1:7. Our hearts desire should be to move in the power of His love. How long has it really been since you felt the fire and presence of God within you? God won't rekindle the gift for us.
