#### Announce

• Right foot, big toe middle knuckle inside next to 2<sup>nd</sup> toe

And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, Who is worthy to open the book, and to loose the seals thereof? Revelation 5:2.

We should not walk in strife. We need to announce to ourselves and to the spirit realm that we will above all else be responsible for and remain in peace. If something is not going well, if we are efforting too much, we are operating in the spirit of strife. If we experience dissension and conflict, pray that God would restore peace to the situation or lead you to a different place and vantage point. Dreams are the Holy Spirit's way of working with us while we are asleep. Our dream images are not always what they seem. In the spirit realm for instance, if you dream of your mother, you may actually have had revealed to you through your unguarded walls the nurturing side of yourself. If you dream of a father figure you may actually be working on the providing, authority figure within and what would be the best for a given situation. If you dream of your mother or father it may also mean for you to pray for them. Anyway, I am getting beside the point. Our dreams carry spirit energy. Every object and feeling you dream has a Discernment point. You need to ask God to show you what He is trying to say and reveal to you. The boundaries in the world of dreams are not the same as the boundaries for our waking state. The Discernment points are however48the same whether awake or asleep.

#### Anxiety

#### Right ankle inside center bone

Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it Be afraid. John14:1.



We all feel anxiety at one time or another. We can be anxious about many things and rightly so. But the Word tells us to cast all our cares on Him because He cares for us. God cares for us whether we are awake or asleep. He is always transmitting His love and divine information to us. Sometimes a person is so set in their ways, the only way He can breakthrough is in sleep, when our physical body is at rest. God speaks to His people not only during their waking hours, but He also gives information to us in dreams. There are many examples throughout the Bible of God speaking to His people in dreams. He spoke to Joseph in the Old Testament. He spoke to Joseph (Mary's husband) in the New Testament. There are many instances throughout scripture where God uses dreams to get vital messages across to us.

I had been praying for a while for God to do some great and mighty things in my life. I was 39 years old and everything seemed to be in a rut, going nowhere. Life seemed like a mediocre substitute for what God really wanted. Every day was unfulfilling, almost a torment no matter what or who I was trying to help. There was a hole, even though I was a Christian. Talk about anxiety – many times it felt like I was going to jump right out of my own skin. And I would wager to say that there are many people who feel just like I did back but are afraid to admitzto the truth.

And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit gave them utterance. Acts 2:4

God has a program and a path for each of us. He does not want us to kill it. Remember, we are co-creators with Him. We can choose to co-create or we can choose our own way, the way to emptiness and nothing in the end.

The Holy Spirit is akin to the British thermal unit if you will. Webster's defines B.T.U. as how much heat is required to raise the temperature of one pound of water by 1 degree Fahrenheit. Think of how much heat and energy it takes God to raise our consciousness of Him by even 1 degree. Wow! When we are born again, it is dynamite power that regenerates us. Throughout our life God release His B.T.U power to us without reservation. It is God power that preserves and keeps us.

At this point, I would like to share a couple of "B.T.U." dreams with you so that you will be able to see and understand how Discernment points work. The bolded print is the discernment point God reveals once you are awake and focused. As you write the dream, you will feel the discernment points where God wishes to give you knowledge. So my friend. get writing your dreams.



#### Bugs me

Right foot 3<sup>rd</sup> toe where it attaches to foot on top

We all have things that bug us, irritate, and downright annoy us. We are to pray for these types of situations. God says for us to ask that we should receive. If we pray for someone be assured He will begin work in that person's life. We may not get to see it, but rest assured He is beginning a work. He wants all to come to knowledge of Him. We believers in Christ here on earth are catalysts to release God's working power on behalf of others.

When you dream of someone, you need to look at the dream dualistically. First, pray for that person. Secondly, write the dream down and let God reveal to you His wisdom. Not too long ago I had a dream about a lady with whom I used to work. In the natural realm I was not too fond of her, but I knew and understood that God loves her beyond all else, just like me. I still pray for her this day.

The following words in parenthesis are the impression points, which reveal the meaning of the dream scenery.

This is the dream: J. L. *(story)* tried to give me a box of diabetes *(rejection)*. Mom said, "No, doesn't own it." *(specific)*. J.L. wrote my name on it and drew pictures of her classroom of kids – stick figure like with some of them going around in circles *(congestive)*. My hair was fuzzy and curly. *(weak)*. She wrote my name. *(bring you dow??*)



### Buy Right foot 4<sup>th</sup> toe top center middle knuckle

For you are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's I Corinthians 6:20.

There is no money on earth that can buy the peace of God. The peace of God surpasses all understanding. It guards our hearts and minds. It keeps us calm amidst the most turbulent of storms in our lives. About four years ago my life was beginning to fall apart. I almost lost my job, was turning 40, wasn't married and didn't feel fulfilled in any way. I'll bet a lot of you can relate to this juncture. A lot of us eventually come to this dark night, if we are on the spiritual journey God has foreordained for us. Money can't buy contentment. Christ on the other hand has already purchased peace of mind for us by and in His Resurrection. God is in the business of getting our attention. As sure as the sun rises, He will get yours whether awake or asleep. Not too long ago I saw my friend S. C. in a dream, a friend whom I had not seen in thirty years and her sister R. (stop). Remember the words in parenthesis are the accompanying impression points to reveal the dream imagery to you in a personal way.

S. and I were in bed. (bring you down). I was eating her and thought it was awful. (mixed up) Like seeds in my mouth. (persecute.) I didn't want a disease. (disorder) I touched her left toe (lust) and she told me she didn't like that. Then I saw J. M. – a lady from the place where I worked with sores around her mouth (weak) – like in real from time to time.



#### Cataracts

#### Bottom of right foot near heel on the outside

The eyes of your understanding being enlightened that ye may know what is the hope of His calling and what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints. Galatians 1:18

God is in the business of removing cataracts from our eyes. He wants us to see clearly. He does not want us wandering through this earth fuzzily and blindly. He wants us to know that He is here presently and with us now. Sometimes after a dream, God will reveal the most astonishing things.

For instance, directly after the last dream I shared with you, there was a morning copy of the local newspaper on the table. I picked it up and started thumbing through it. It was unbelievable. In big print was my friend's name. She had just passed from a female type of cancer. I couldn't believe it, but there it was. I had not thought of my childhood friend for 30 years.

Dreams are dualistic, not only do they carry Discernment energy, they also reveal for whom you need to add to your prayer list. I knew that I was supposed to pray for her sister, R. in the situation as well.



#### Check

Right foot second toe middle knuckle next to big toe

I have heard the check of my reproach, And the spirit of my understanding causeth me to answer. Job 20:3.

This particular Discernment point is sort of a homonym. It refers to "check" as to look at, not the monetary note. There is place on the right hand for that particular kind of check. God wants us to be watchful over the things we allow in our life. There is a check that comes in our spirit man when something is not right. Dreams help us to process every day events as God gives His thoughts on them. He also tells us who and what we need to be praying for as His ambassadors. In the following discourse, the words in italic are points of discernment.

In this particular dream instance, I was in Atlanta to see Uncle Joe with my Mom and Dad. (Bring you down, I'm still here.) We were in a car and Uncle Joe was driving. (wild, freed) There was snow on the hill (dirt, floor). We went to McDonald's. (situation, stay). In real life, my parents were planning a vacation to Georgia to stay with Uncle Joe. God was teaching me I needed to pray for even vacations in a dream. When Dad got back, he said that he had fallen on a slippery surface and hurt his side quite a bit. Nothing is irrelevant in dreams. We are to pray at all times with all perseverance for all the saints. 254

# Right foot 3<sup>rd</sup> toe Confusion cuticle



For God is not the author of confusion, but of peace. I Corinthians 14;33

There is so much confusion in the world today. The media gives its slant on a situation. This person gives his thoughts and that person, their thoughts, but no one really has a solution, a fix for any of the real problems in the world today. We aren't really sailing anywhere. We are simply hanging onto a life raft for rescue. But who is going to come and save us? It feels like everything in the natural realm is on the verge of careening out of control into nothing but utter confusion and embarrassment.

...Isaiah shares with us about the unseen realm. He talks of the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, and the spirit of the knowledge and the fear of the Lord. When these six spirits are operating in their fullness, there will be no more confusion. Isaiah states that God Almighty shall make Him (and us eventually because we will be like Him) of quick understanding in the fear of the Lord, you will absolutely refuse to do what He does not want you to do. You will understand that there are consequences in the spirit realm that translate into the natural rather whether for good or for bad. We all have to start at the beginning in spiritual matters no matter how advanced we are in earthly facts whether we are 30, 40, or 50, or even 60 plus years old.



#### Dampen


#### Right foot side and under in the middle

Thus saith the Lord of hosts, if thou wilt walk in My ways, and if thou wilt keep my charge, then thou shalt also judge my house, and shalt also keep my courts, and I will give thee places to walk among those that stand by. Zechariah 3:7.

God will teach us and enable us to live without being selfcentered and selfish. He will teach us how to be God centered. If you live only for yourself, your life will have dampened potential. You will not be able to flourish and become all that you are meant to become if you languor in self above all else. Selfishness produces a generalized non-caring for others. One only cares for what they can get and how they can use another to their own aggrandizement. When this sort of attitude is allowed to fester and take root, anger becomes a major facet of the personality. When we're not satisfied, we are upset.

If we want to walk in Discernment, we cannot dampen His efforts to strengthen us by selfishness, anger or any other thing, which could stand in the way. God does not judge by the sight of his eyes nor reprove by the hearing of his ears and neither should we. God sees the heart. With righteousness Isaiah continues, God shall judge the earth. In other words, He will judge in truth. He wants for us to share in this truth as well. The Holy Spirit's Truth is nothing we can think or dream up. It is entirely different and you are promised to know it. When we step in His truth, He will give us places to walk and we will keep His house and judge His courts.

#### Distracted

I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus. Philippians 3:14.

We can all be easily distracted from what we are supposed to be doing. We can make ourselves so busy in fact that we forget what we've even done by day's end. Distraction in other words is that which takes your eyes off your focus. We are to press toward the mark of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus. Philippians 3:14. When we see Him, we will be like Him. God Almighty wants to reveal Himself. You can grow in the image of Him bit by bit right now. . . This is not a process that begins when we get to heaven. It is a process, which we embark on right here. God can even help us keep our focus while we sleep and to help us help others keep their focus as well.

I had a dream about a couple which our family knows quite well. All I saw was their faces, nothing more, no action or any other thing – no distractions. As I was dreaming, I felt a discernment point on my left foot. I knew that particular impression meant problems. As a result of this dream, I took the action I thought God would want me to take and throughout the course of the next day I prayed in tongues at various times for these two as the Holy Spirit brought them to mind. 257

#### Expire

Be thou removed, Mark 11:23

Haven't we all gone out to a parking meter at one time or another only to discover the time has expired and we need to put more money in the meter. We feel pretty lucky if we don't have a ticket. When God let's us know something has expired, we need to leave it be. It would be nice if we could just put another coin in to our endeavors, but that's not how this world is set up. God is sovereign we are not. If something we are doing isn't working after we have tried and prayed with all our heart, it may be that it has expired for you. It may have been right for you at one time, but one thing's for certain in this life and that is change. Things come and things go, but God is forever. For a short while I had a cleaning lady come and help once a week to help keep things in order. The Holy Spirit is concerned with every area of our lives - even cleaning but this weekly cleaning time eventually expired. I had a dream not too long before we stopped cleaning together. And this is what it was. The words in parenthesis are the correlating discernment points in the dream scenery. C. came in (weak) the back of the house by the garbage cans (attention) I was thinking, "oh no" (not there for you). She put on a wig to meet (complicated, incorrect, missing, I don't want to do this, bring you down) my Mom and Dad and acted nice. 258

#### Under side right foot under pads of 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> toe.

This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth Joshua 1:8.

Seek ye first the kingdom of God and His righteousness and all these things shall be added unto you. Matthew 6:33. When we put God first, He will put us first. When we do things His way, the kingdom way, we will not scramble as the un-believing world. We are to be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication we are to let our requests be made known unto God. Philippians 4:6. It is promised that the peace of God, which passes all understanding, will guard our hearts and minds in Christ Jesus. How the cry of the human heart is to be first at all cost. This is just something we are born with. It is not something we develop. Listen to a baby sometime. They get the attention they want and they get it immediately by crying or throwing a good yell. They only know about themselves. How sad it is that so many adults have never grown out of this stage of development. They only think of themselves and how their needs can be met. When we talk badly of others we are behaving like a baby. We need to take our thumb from our moth and raise both hands to heaven. Once again, I had a dream. And I am sharing this to encourage you to explore your dreams for their wisdom to you.

I saw J's face. He was talking badly about motorcycles and me. I felt the following discernment points: Problems, significant, service, lust, trampled. In order to help in the unseen realm, we need to practice empathy and to realize those 5 spirits in their operation and to pray.

#### Fraud

Fraud is everywhere we turn today. People are pretending to be what they are not. Products proffer to deliver results that can never really happen. People make promises they cannot or won't keep. Deception is rampant in different manifestations any place you care to look. God wants us to find our sufficiency in Him. When we do, we will not have to be part of the crazy masquerade. Discernment points assist the believer in determining what truth is and what is not.

Not too long ago, I lost my job. God really had to go and dig deep to get me out of there. I never would have left on my own. I felt pretty bad about the whole incident and God knew my exact feelings about all the strife and wonderment. That night He gave me the most comforting dream. I asked Him right before I went to sleep why I had lost my job. In the dreamscape the Holy Spirit said the reason this happened was "to take me away from the evil." I certainly was uncomfortable in my job but still I wouldn't leave, after all we need security in this fleshly existence. What the world may see as something bad, God has better purposes intended. He cuts through fraud. Who is your God and leader? Man, money, or

That is all that really matters in light of eternity. We are told to Go and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost, teaching them to observe all things He has commanded us. He promises to be with us in everything we do. One cannot be a partaker in the heavenly kingdom without being born of the spirit. What is spirit is spirit. What is flesh is flesh. Flesh only produces death. Spirit produces life. We are to go and aid others in being a part of "life." We are to banish and make hatred and faithlessness go from our lives. Right foot back of heel 1st line on the side (where "program" is on left foot


I would not have you ignorant brethren...Romans 1:13

Ignorance is rampant, alive and well in the world today. The results of ignorance are everywhere as evidenced by divorce, murder, theft, people unable to get along with one another, wars, conflicts, genocide, and the list goes ad infinitum.

Many of us have areas in our life, which don't have any get up and go. Though we may daydream and think about doing one thing or another, all our dreaming cannot enable us with the power we need. Jesus tells us that the kingdom of heaven can be compared with 10 young ladies. 5 of them were wise and five of them were foolish. Matthew 25:1. We all need to take stock of our lives and discern to which group we currently belong - the wise or the foolish. The parable says that the foolish took their lamps with them but they forgot the oil. Let's think about this for just a moment. If we don't remember to put gas in our car we are not going anywhere soon. If we do not pay the propane bill, our house will be unable to keep a comfortable temperature. And so it is with us. If we forget to take God's Holy Spirit oil of anointing in our vessels -ourselves, we would be as the foolish because there would be no divine power or capacity to motivate our desire with any type of power, sphere, or influence. We must daily anoint ourselves in the Holy Ghost. He is always there; we just need to remember to hook up with Him.

#### I'm Still Here


• Right foot top big toe where knuckle attaches to foot

Now as the bridegroom was out doing other things, all the young ladies went to bed for the evening with no idea when their bridegroom would arrive. The air must have been sizzling with anticipation. Amidst all this, our parable here teaches us that we need to always be vigilant, keeping our spirits lubricated with the Holy Ghost whether awake or asleep. The Holy Ghost is the great enabler. God is always whispering to our spirits "I'm still here, I will always be here." He enables us to go through things and do things with ease that would otherwise be difficult if not impossible on natural strength.

Suddenly, the parable says, a cry was made at midnight proclaiming the bridegroom on his way. All the girls were to get up and be ready. The festive occasion and hour was at hand. The foolish and the wise would both soon journey to very different circumstances because of choices made.



#### Insecure

He gives me the sure-footedness of a mountain goat upon the crags. Psalm 18:36.

There are many times in life when we have to deal with insecurity. We all have to face it at one level one time or another. God promises to be with us however no matter the situation. Sometimes a problem may seem almost insurmountable to our natural way of thinking. God does not want us to be double minded. He wants us to have the faith to realize that He can calm the worst of storms in an instant. He is in the boat with us. We are not alone. The Heavenly Father tells us that as He was with Moses so He will be with us. He will strengthen us. He will help us. He will uphold us. He will guide us. The God of all ages will not let your boat go down before you have run the race set before you. Every instance of insecurity you feel and experience is an opportunity for God to show you His security. The devil on the other hand wants you to feel insecure. He wants you to be timid and inert. He will try to shove you into a corner. But God intervenes on behalf of His saints and tells us that when we are weak, that is precisely the moment, if we are relying on Him when we become strong. People truly want something that is real, something to believe in, any-thing. Even if it is false, people want something more. An assurance, if you will, of a spiritual realm that exists, that works, that functions, that cares, that would be willing to share a glimpse of greater power and vision. People are crying out for want of something that is right now and relevant. People want to know more, they want help, a hand up.

God does have something for us now. He has the jewel of discernment poised for His people to partake. Discernment is wisdom from above to enable an understanding beyond any doubt as to what type of spirit or stumbling block is behind an action or a person's façade. God is not the author of confusion, ignorance, and darkness He is the God of light.

#### Other Direction


#### Top of right 4<sup>th</sup> toe where foot connects at the knuckle.

And they shall teach my people the difference between the holy and profane, and cause them to discern between the unclean and the clean. II Chronicles 32:22.

Music is an instrument given by God to man to bring and release strength and relationship to individual believers. Discernment alone is opened and unveiled by God Himself to His people. There are things however which we can practice as a daily catalyst for receiving discernment. Music is a facilitator for the release of power from God's hand to our heart. Music has within itself a seed of vibration that sets forth and unleashes discernment in each of us. It is almost like a musical note on our body. Scripture says we are to make a joyful noise. When we make a noise, God returns His sound to us. Faith is not a one-way conversation. Faith is not a thing just to be thrown about. Faith is relationship with God Almighty. Discernment is received by faith. It feels like an electrical pulse from the inside out. I believe God wants to help the body of Christ understand what this outpouring of intimacy is and to have all people even if not fully walking in Discernment, to be aware that this power of relationship is available to believers today. The book of Hebrews tell us that strong meat belongs to them that are of full age even to those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil. Hebrews 5:14.

The high praises of God shall be in their throats and a two edged sword in their hands. Psalm 149:6

We are to be gentle doves yet wise as serpents in this world. Matthew 10:16. We must love others with the love, which Christ loved us but we are not to be persuaded or usurped in the spiritual venue. We are to guard what God has told and given us with the greatest of care. Many well-meaning people will unknowingly take and rob you of your very God given path. They may say that what we are doing is wrong or that it is impossible or that it is too much. Our heavenly Father sees all these things and He is shaping us to become ever vigilant, just as He is. Gently He is teaching us to guard our very words. Words are the great power sources. With them we bless and speak creation. With them we can also curse and release negative energy. We must guard what we say to others. Our mouth is the catalyst for both life and death. God gives to His children treasures of value along various sections of our journey. Sometimes valued treasures are brought forth from irritation itself. And because of this very fact Matthew reminds us that we are not supposed to strare all our priority nuggets of truth with those who are not prepared.

Only those who are ready can hear and not turn and dash under foot irreplaceable truths. Doubt is a robber of the brethren. Matthew admonishes us that we are not to cast our pearls to swine. Not that any of us are swine, but it is human proclivity to trample under foot albeit unknowingly the hard won gains of wisdom and growth. We must always guard our tongue. 
Study to show thyself approved unto God, II Timothy 2:15

Let your speech be with grace. Colossians 4:6.




