

Arm Right Holy Spirit impressions on the right arm






Bathroom

Blessed be the Lord, who daily loadeth us with benefits, even the God of our salvation. Selah. Psalms 68:19.





Contract


Right arm under elbow on soft tissue



For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against the spiritual wickedness in high places.


Ephesians 6:12


Market




Practically finished

Jesus saith unto them, My meat is to do the will of him that sent me, and to finish his work. John 4:34





Right wrist outside bone



Snakes




The wicked are estranged from the womb – their poison is like the poison of a serpent: they are like the deaf adder that stoppeth her ear. Psalm 58: 3, 4


Stop


